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WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

Students attending – both in a full- or part-time mode - universities or universities of applied sciences **IN South Tyrol:**

- ➔ EU citizens
- ➔ Non-EU citizens with a long-term residence permit
- ➔ Non-EU citizens with a permit, but without a long-term residence permit that have been registered in South Tyrol without interruption for at least one year

Students attending – both in a full- or part-time mode - universities or universities of applied sciences **OUTSIDE South Tyrol:**

- ➔ All students, **regardless of their citizenship**, provided that they have had their registered residence for at least two years without interruption in South Tyrol.

Non-EU citizens attention please:

- ➔ You must **submit the residence permit for Italy personally** to the Office for Higher Education Support by the **3rd November 2026, 12 noon**.
- ➔ You shall **certify facts** that cannot be confirmed or certified by private or public Italian entities, according to the requirements indicated in the call of competition and **attaching them to the online form**.
- ➔ If you have **no long-term residence permit** must also provide evidence of the following information using the corresponding documents:
 - registered place of residence of core family members abroad (certificate of residence),
 - own minor children with a registered place of residence abroad (family status form).

I'VE HEARD I NEED THE EEVE-DURP DECLARATION. WHAT'S THAT?

The economic situation of the applicant and her or his nuclear family is determined by the **EEVE-DURP declaration (Unified declaration of income and assets)** and the **value of the economic situation (FWL-VSE)**. The **EEVE-DURP declaration** and the **value of the economic situation (FWL-VSE)** can be obtained from the **tax assistance centers (CASF)** or from a **Patronat-patronato** (mediator centre between citizens and public bodies) located in South Tyrol. Detailed information and a complete list of the Patronats-patronati can be downloaded on the homepage of **EEVE-DURP declaration** [Dichiarazione unificata di reddito e patrimonio \(DURP\)](#).

HOW CAN I APPLY?

- ➔ **Directly ONLINE** through the **myCivis** portal using the **Public System of Digital Identity (SPID)**, the **electronic identity card (CIE)**, the **European digital identity systems (eIDAS)** or alternatively by requesting access using an **activated citizen/health card**.
- ➔ **Foreign citizens** who are **not entitled to one of the above-mentioned means of identification** can **only access the online services with a certified account**. It is also possible to **apply for the creation of a certified account** in the case of **technical verifiable obstacles in the use of eIDAS**.

For the **creation of the certified account**, the student can:

- **appear in person** at the Office for University Support, **by appointment**, and present an **identity card/identification card**, the **Italian tax code** and the **self-declaration related to university enrolment**,
- **make an appointment for a video call** with the Office by sending an e-mail to dirittostudio.universitario@provincia.bz.it and attaching to the e-mail the filled out application form (available on the Office's homepage), a **copy of the identity card/identification card**, the **document of the Italian tax code** and a **copy of the self-declaration related to university enrolment**.
- In addition, **one or two years of residence in South Tyrol** must be proven in order to apply for a scholarship.

WHEN CAN I APPLY?

Application period is **from 22nd September 2026 till 3rd November 2026, 12:00 noon.**

WHEN IS THE PROVISIONAL RANKING PUBLISHED?

The **provisional ranking** will be published on the **27th November 2026.**

WHEN CAN I MODIFY THE APPLICATION?

- ➔ Applications which have been completed but not yet sent to the Office can be amended at any time before the deadline.
- ➔ Sent applications may be cancelled and it is possible to submit a new application if this is done by the deadline of **3rd November 2026, 12 noon.**
- ➔ After publication of the provisional ranking list, it will be possible to **correct the application** during the period **from 27th November till 11th December 2026, 12:00 noon.**

Attention: **Only one correction** of the application is possible and will be **accepted!**

WHEN IS THE DEFINITIVE RANKING PUBLISHED?

The **definitive ranking** will be published by **12th February 2027**

WHEN WILL THE STUDY GRANT BE PAID?

The study grant will **be paid** by **31st March 2027.**

WHAT ELSE DO I HAVE TO CONSIDER?

- ➔ Applicants must have achieved the minimum academic merit indicated in the yearly call for competition for the enrolled year when applying (see table below).
- ➔ To apply, it is necessary to be already enrolled at university (NB: Therefore, it is not enough to be enrolled only conditionally).
- ➔ Awardees of a study grant – **both in a full- or part-time mode** - are required to achieve an academic record of **at least 10 credit points (ECTS) in the academic year 2026/2027**, otherwise the study grant must be returned.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE ACADEMIC MERIT

Students must achieve the minimum academic success required for a scholarship in the respective academic year **by the moment of the presentation of the application and in any case by the 31st October 2026** (The request for the **first** year of studies is submitted referring to the high school diploma):

For the eighth academic year (15th/16th semester)	315 ECTS	157,5 ECTS

NB: Only credits already effectively registered and accredited by the university can be declared in the online form.

WHAT IS PART-TIME STUDYING?

The status of part-time students applies **only to those who are officially enrolled on a part-time mode** and follow the normal duration of the course, without being behind schedule. Students who take courses alongside with work or distance learning, without being officially enrolled as part-time students, are not considered as such.
